Position Objective

The **Technician** – is responsible for assisting the Technical Officer – Nausori Zone with the provision of sound advice relating to Wastewater processes and compliance requirements within WAF. This responsibility includes facilitating and improving the provisioning of wastewater network services across Nasinu & Nausori Wastewater network. Conducting service delivery and fault complaints resolution as well as routine inspection, audit, verification and maintenance of network infrastructure in accordance with best practices. The position reports to Technical Officer – Nausori Zone

Key Accountabilities

1. Effective and efficient operations of Wastewater Network in Nausori.

- Conduct fault classification as per WAF Fault Classification Dashboards
- Resolve customer complaints as per WAF Customer Charter
- Conduct routine checks and inspections across WAF's Wastewater Pumping Stations
- Maintain clean and safe working environment within and around Pump Station Sites
- Inspect, service and repair components of the Wastewater Pumping Stations including pipe works, wet well and guide rails, fencing and gantry support, switchboards, valves and pits and report to Technical Officer.
- Ensure minimal overflow of wastewater overflows from wastewater networks.



- Ensure security of Wastewater Pumping Station sites.
- Conduct regular unblocking, flushing and bailing programs for WAF's Wastewater Networks and pipelines.
- Conduct repair woks for minor and major pipeline bursts and collapses.
- Submit Weekly Operational Data to Technical Officer for the WW Dashboards.
